

The Rayat Shikshan Sanstha founded by late Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil in 1919, is one of the leading educational institutions in Asia. "There should not be a village without school and a school without a trained teacher". This is the ideal, the founder of the Rayatr Shikshan Sanstha, the late Padmabhushan Dr. Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Cherished and earnestly struggled for throughout his life. The sincerely believed, a teacher from masses who knowns the rural community with all its ills can effectively educate the students belongi9ng to the rural areas. How to get trained teachers in such a

large number was a genuine problem. To satisfy the growing demand of the trained leaders for the secondary schools which he has started in nooks and corners in remote areas of Maharashtra for the education of masses, he strongly felt the need of having Sanstha's own secondary teacher's training college.

Realising the basic need of secondary schools, the founder of the sanstha opened a secondary teachers' training college in 1955 at the historical place Satara city. To commemorate the memory of the late Honorable Moulana Abdul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of Government of India the college was renamed as Azad College of Education, Satara in 1958.

The institution has a glorious tradition of outstanding achievements in the university examinations right from the beginning. Most times results were hundred percent and very often closer to it. Every year the students for the college secure ranks in the university merit list. Most often times the topper is from this college and the merit list consists of three to four students consistently. #### H) About the Faculty:

Academic excellence has always been prominent feature of the college. The faculty consist of Eleven Ph.D. holders and Seven M.Phil holders, Six faculty members are enggged in their Ph.D. work.

# I) Learning Resources:

- 1) Library: The library is computerized. It is very rich with number of Reference books, Text books, Journals and periodicals, Every year the library is enriched with latest arrivals. The number of books in the library is near about 28000. There is a book bank facility in the library for the students. The libraray has member of N-List of INFLBNET with 90000 e-Books and 3000 e-Journals. There I a separate Reading room facility for the staff and students. The Library has subscribed various Marathi and English Newspapers.
- 2) Computer Laboratory: The college computer laboratory is well equipped having 32 computers with internet connectivity. This learning resource centre helps the students to complete their PPT practical work and prove the computer literacy and the skills.
- 3) Science Laboratory: This laboratory has a pivotal place in the teaching-learning process. College has a resourceful and equipped science laboratory with full of scientific instruments, models, charts etc. this laboratory is also attached with a Mathematics corner. The student-trainees got benefitted this laboratory for practice-teaching and other activities.
- 4) Psychological Laboratory: The college has a independent psychology laboratory containing with all psychological resources including different types of test. This laboratory provides training to students to administer psychological tests and conduct the psychological experiments.

- 5) Educational Technology Laboratory: The college has a separate educational technology laboratory with different types of educational aids useful for teachinglearning process i.e. Tape recorder, Radio, O.H.P. Television, Slide Projector, Epidiascope, Film Projector, Filmstrips, Transparencies etc.
- 6) Research Cell: the college has separate Research Cell attached with reference section in the library. This cell provide facility to students and the staff to complete their research work and publishing research articles and papers.
- 7) S.U.P.W. Workshop: The section of the SUPW in the college organizes varied activities like book binding, spiral binding, screen printing, envelope making, chalk making, interior decoration etc. these activities helps to develop vocational attitude among the students.
- 8) English Language Lab: The college has Digital English Language Lab with 'Linguaphone-21' with Eyespeak software. This is the Word's most successful program to learn global spoken English. Every year college has run 'English speaking and Personality Development Programme'. (Soft Skill Development) with three month's duration. This program included English Curriculum. speech Recognition software.

- J) Extension Service Centre: This centre is one of the special features of the college. Since the establishment in 1971, it provides in service training facilities to secondary teachers in the district with the help of District Education Dept., SCERT,SSC Board and the subject teachers organizations.

- K) Career Guidance and Placement Cell: This cell provides career information, job opportunities to students with Guidance and counseling. it organizes campus interviews also.
- L) Hostels: A separate hostels for boys and the girls are located in the college premises. The boys hostel accommodates 30 students and girl's hostel accommodates 60 female students. Both the hostels facilitated with hot water and the purified drinking water.

- P) Anti-Ragging: Ragging is strictly prohibited as per the order of the Supreme Court. If any student is found guilty in this context, then he will be subject to the following legal punishment.




